Definition of Job Roles Develop clear role definitions across Acute CNS banding (Band 5 → Band 8 ACP). Aim: standardise expectations and career progression pathways. 2. Service Specifications Create standardised service specifications for AKI CNS follow-up services. Focus on consistency across trusts and clarity on nurse vs consultant-led pathways.
