Guest speaker session: Jodie Fahy, Pharmacosmos	Presentation: "optimising Iron Deficiency Anaemia management in CKD for better patient outcomes and quality of life" With opportunity to ask questions to Jodie Fahy.	Jodie Fahy Kindly presented about the importance of optimising iron Deficiency Anaemia in CKD for better patient outcomes and quality of Life. Jodie reported the findings of the Ferwon Nephron study -a trial that evaluated the safety and efficacy of iron isomaltose and the NIMO CKD study- a real-world study demonstrating the effectiveness of initial higher doses of iron isomaltose in Non-dialysis CKD patients.
